

Mega International Commercial Bank 2024 Occupational Safety and Health Management Program (January - December 2024)

I. Purpose: To enhance all our employees' safety and health, increase their awareness of safety and health, improve the work environment and facilities, the Bank plans to implement the occupational safety and health management program to achieve the goal of zero accident.

II. Basis: This program is established in accordance with Article 23 of the Occupational Safety and Health Act and Article 31 of the Enforcement Rules of the Occupational Safety and Health Act.

III. Scope: It applies to all employees, relevant facilities, equipment in workplace, and safety and management matters of the Bank within the scope defined by the Occupational Safety and Health Act
